- 1. If you could give any gift to anyone, who would you give it to and what would you give them?
- 2. Why is it important to always remember that Christianity is a gift?
- 3. Think of people you know who have had some of the privileges of being taught the Bible (a Christian family, or belonging to a church) but are now hardened against Christ. In what ways do we get used to their unbelief, and cease to grieve over it? Why do we get used to it?
- 4. What is the nature of grace? Examine Romans 11:11 in light of Romans 5:20.
- 5. How does Paul describe his ministry in Romans 11:13-15?
- 6. In what ways do believers make unbelievers envious of a life with God?
- 7. How does living in community amplify the grace?
- 8. In what ways have you seen the beauty of grace in the lives of others? How can we live together as Christians to show this attractive kindness of God?
- 9. How can this chapter help us not to give up on people who are hardened to the gospel?
- 10. What is it that has made Paul so very thrilled about God at the end? (Romans 11:33-36)
