Opening Up:

Reference: 1 Corinthians 16

Discuss:

Chapter 16 of 1 Corinthians is like a staff meeting of the early church. This chapter reveals qualities of a christian movement. A church movement requires...

- 1. Generosity (16:1-4)
- 2. Vision (16:5-11)
- 3. Leadership (16:12-17)
- 4. Jesus (16:19-21)

Generosity

- 1. In verse 2 Paul instructs people to put aside an offering on the first day of the week as they prosper. What about the church's mission inspires your generosity?
- 2. What about Jesus' gift to you inspires your generosity towards Him?

Vision

- 3. Paul seeks permission from Jesus (16:7). Do you ask Jesus for permission to make decisions in your life? How does someone go about seeking the will of God?
- 4. Paul sees opportunity despite the opposition (16:9). Are you more likely (naturally) to see opposition or opportunity?
- 5. Are you facing any opposition? What open doors for the gospel are present in your life right now?

Leadership

- 6. In 16:13-14 we read about having courage inspired by love. In what ways have you had to be courageous for someone you love?
- 7. We are told to recognize and submit to those who have devoted themselves to the service of the saints. (16:15-18) Is there someone in your life who has honorably served the church?

Jesus

- 8. You can not give what you do not have. You can give Jesus to a desperate world when have not first been desperate for Jesus. How does your life with Jesus need to some intensity?
