- 2. What does creation show us about God? (1:18-20)
- 3. Why is God angry? (1:18, 21-23)
- 4. What does ingratitude expose about the heart? (1:21)
- 5. How does God respond to our ungratefulness? (1:24-31)
- 6. In what ways is God kind to us? (2:4)
- 7. How are we tempted to "presume" on his kindness?
- 8. Three times it is mentioned that "God gave them up to" in 24, 26, and 28. What does Paul mean by this phrase?
- 9. Paul's main point is to illustrate that "everyone needs the gospel" by showing the disordered affections of humanity. In what ways are your desires out of order? That is, what do I want that I know I ought not to want, and what do I not want that I know I ought to want?
- 10. What would it be like to live in a town where all the people were like those described in verses 28-32, especially those depicted in 32?
- 11. What does Paul teach about homosexual desires and how do they illustrate his main point? (1:24-27)
- 12. Why does condemning bad behaviors in others condemn me too? (2:1-4) How does this show my everyday need for the gospel?
