- 1. Why is grace not fair and why do we need it?
- 2. What would a world without grace and only law (rules) look like?
- 3. If you were telling a friend what life in the Kingdom was like, what would you say?
- 4. How is God's Kingdom different from the kingdoms of this world?
- 5. How is grace an equalizing force?
- 6. How does the equalizing effect of the gospel sometimes offend us? (See the parable in verse 12)
- 7. How would you describe what it means in verse 16 when it says the "last will be first, and the first last"?
- 8. You can only receive all of God's eternal grace, you can not receive a portion of grace. How does this make you feel about God's generosity? (See verse 15)
- 9. How does the gospel (the ethic of the kingdom) help you to feel both humility and courage? How does it affect how you live your everyday life?
