- 6. In Isaiah 55 we see that God offers us a meal without cost. He offers us grace! God's table is a table of grace. How has your actual table in your home been shaped by the grace of God?
- 7. What should be different about the way Christians eat? What should be different about who Christians eat with?
- 8. Is it hard for you to imagine sharing a meal with someone different from you?

 - 2. Who is someone in your life you could BLESS with a meal?
- 9. Did you bless three this week? If so, who? How can the group pray?
