- 4. Jesus died for sins. (15:3) How does receiving that truth affect you psychologically?
- 5. Sometime in eternity past God decided to create the world knowing what it would cost him to save us, and he created us anyway. How does this help you understand the love of God? (Ephesians 1:4)
- 6. Have you ever been caught in the Performance Trap (My Value = My performance + Other's Opinions)? How so?
- 7. How does grace help you to get out of performance addiction?
- 8. Paul says that we are "being saved" by the Gospel. What evidence of God's salvation in your life have you seen in the past year? (15:2)
- 9. Is anyone struggling in their faith? (As group seek to encourage.)
